

## What is the Foundation that GOD called Women to teach and Preach

Some use Galatians 3:27 - 28 as the foundation!  
(27) For as many of you as have been baptized  
into Christ have put on Christ (28) There is  
neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither bond  
nor free, **there is neither male nor female:** for  
ye are all one in Christ Jesus.

**But, where is the record that GOD called  
women to preach and teach?**

**Acts 16:11-15 God Opens Lydia's Heart to  
Attend to the Things That Apostle Paul Taught!**

Acts 16: 13, Luke writes about a woman  
named Lydia. **(1) She worshipped GOD and  
(2) GOD opened her heart! And GOD gave  
(3) Lydia instructions to attend unto the  
things that Paul taught. Lydia attended to  
those things - all in her household were  
saved and there was a church established  
in her home in Thyatira!**

**The Record of Women Laboring in the Gospel**

Apostle Paul commended some of them in  
Romans chapter 16. Some scholars believe  
Paul wrote this book in A.D. 57 or A.D. 58

**Romans 16:1-2**

**Sister Phoebe's role as a deaconess**

**Aquila and Priscilla had a church in their  
house Records show Priscilla was a teacher**

**Romans 16:7 Paul commends Apostle Junia!  
She was an Apostle before Apostle Paul**

**Apostle Paul Implored Two Women who  
labored with him in the Gospel to be of the  
same mind. Philippians 4:2-3 says: "I beseech  
Euodias, and beseech Syntyche, that they be of  
the same mind in the Lord.**

**Apostle Paul Encouraged the Men to help the  
Women, who Labour with him in the gospel!**

(3) And I intreat thee also, true yokefellow,  
help those women which labour with me in the  
gospel, with Clement also, and with other my  
fellowlabourers, whose names are in the book  
of life. Philippians was written in A.D. 61

**It is clear that God has not commanded women to  
keep silent in the Church.** We see how GOD  
opened Lydia's heart and instructed her to teach  
and preach. The records also show that Apostle  
Paul commended a woman Apostle who was an  
Apostle before JESUS called him.

**However, in 1 Timothy 2:11-12, Apostle Paul  
writes:** 11 Let the woman learn in silence with  
all subjection. 12 But I suffer not a woman to  
teach, nor to usurp authority over the man,  
but to be in silence.

**God is not double-minded!**

**GOD used Apostle Paul in a mighty way;  
however, GOD never said: "He suffers not  
a woman to teach."**

**2 Timothy 3:16-17, Apostle Paul writes: "All  
scripture is given by inspiration of God.."**

**But JESUS gave us a way to determine if the  
doctrine was of men of GOD; 1 Timothy 2:11  
does not meet the standard that gave us in  
John 7:16-18 - This doctrine is of the Apostle  
Paul and not of GOD! Moreover, in A.D. 49,  
Apostle Paul wrote Galatians 1:8-9; listen  
"I suffer not a woman to teach and a woman  
being saved in childbearing" is a new doctrine.**

## **The Word of GOD Gives Us a way to Determine if Doctrines are of GOD or Men**

Let's see what Jesus says,

John 7:16-18

16 Jesus answered them, and said, **My doctrine is not mine, but his that sent me. 17 If any man will do his will, he shall know of the doctrine, whether it be of God, or whether I speak of myself. 18 He that speaketh of himself seeketh his own glory: but he that seeketh his glory that sent him, the same is true, and no unrighteousness is in him.**

This provision is **key** to determining if women are allowed to teach, preach, and be pastors of the church! However, this provision has been overlooked by most!

**It is important to observe what JESUS said here.**

**(1) My doctrine is not mine**

**(2) He that speaketh of himself seeketh his own glory**

## **It also important to consider what Apostle wrote in A. D. 49**

Galatians 1: 8-9 Apostle Paul writes:

8 "But though **we**, or **an angel from heaven**, preach any other gospel unto you than that which we have preached unto you, let him be accursed.

9 As we said before, so say I now again, **If any man preach any other gospel** unto you than that ye have received, let him be accursed."

**It is very important to make note of this because Apostle Paul was even including himself when he wrote these inspired words of God in the name of JESUS; again Apostle Paul wrote this around A.D. 49.**

Today some restrict women from preaching and holding the position of pastor, bishop, etc based on what is written in 1 Corinthians 14:33-36 and 1 Timothy 2:9-15.

**First, let's examine what is written in 1 Corinthians 14:34-36**

34 Let your women keep silence in the churches: for it is not permitted unto them to speak; but they are commanded to be under obedience, as also saith the law. 35 And if they will learn any thing, let them ask their husbands at home: for it is a shame for women to speak in the church.

36 **What?** came the word of God out from you? or came it unto you only?

**(This is an Admonishment!)**

## **Most versions of the Bible have removed "What?" from 1 Corinthians 14:36.**

This single action changes the true message that Apostle Paul conveyed to the Saints at Corinth. This sentence: **"What?"** is there to bring into question the text that preceded the sentence: **"What?"** It is clear that Apostle Paul admonishes these saints through this communication.

**Readers of these versions of the Bible have been misled and believe that the text says women should be silent in the church.**

2 Timothy 3:16-17, Apostle Paul writes: "All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: that the man of God may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all good works." Surely, this is a true statement. However, men have changed some of the text in the Bible; and today, some of the texts in the Bible do not meet the standard that JESUS gave us for the doctrine of GOD.

**Today, some churches adhere to these instructions that Apostle Paul wrote A. D. 63 1 Timothy 2:11-15.**

11 Let the **woman learn in silence** with all subjection. 12 **But I suffer not a woman to teach**, nor to usurp authority over the man, but to be in silence. 13 For Adam was first formed, then Eve. 14 And Adam was not deceived, but the woman being deceived was in the transgression.

15 Notwithstanding **she shall be saved in childbearing**, if they continue in faith and charity and holiness with sobriety.

**Let's review the foundation that some use to justify women not teaching and preaching.**
