

**JESUS came in His Father's name and was tasked to Declare the name of The Father!**

**The children of Israel defiled the Holy name of the Lord that Moses declared, by the abominations that they committed.**

God said that he would sanctify his great name, "which was profaned among the heathen, which ye have profaned in the midst of them; and the heathen shall know that I am the LORD, saith the Lord God, when I shall be sanctified in you before their eyes." (Ezekiel 36:23)

In Ezekiel 39:7 God said, "I will make my holy name known in the midst of my people Israel; and I will not let them pollute my holy name anymore: and the heathen shall know that I am the LORD, the Holy One of Israel."

**Jesus Christ was tasked to declare the name of the Father; Jesus Christ accomplished this task in the midst of the people of Israel.**

In John 17:26, Jesus Christ says, "And I have declared unto them thy name, and will declare it: that the love wherewith thou hast loved me may be in them, and I in them." This was the fulfillment of the prophecy as recorded in Ezekiel 39:7.

In John 14:26, JESUS said that the **Father would sent the Holy Ghost in His name.**

In John 12:23 Jesus says, "The hour is come, that the **Son of man should be glorified.**" In John 12:28-29, Jesus says, "**Father, glorify thy name.**" "Then came there a voice from heaven, saying I have both glorified it, and **will glorify it again.**" The Father said I have both glorified it."

**Note: Some versions of the Bible have changed "both" to "already" - this is a mistake. John 13:31-32 shows that the name was glorified for both the Father and the Son. And He will glorify it again - this is for The Holy Ghost.**

In John 16:16 Jesus said: "A little while, and ye shall not see me: and again, a little while, and ye shall see me, because I go to the Father." In John 16:23-26, Jesus says, "And in that day ye shall ask me nothing. Verily, verily, I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall ask the **Father in my name, he will give it you. Hitherto have ye asked nothing in my name:** ask, and ye shall receive, that your joy may be full. ... but the time cometh, when I shall no more speak unto you in proverbs, but **I shall show you plainly of the Father. At that day ye shall ask in my name:**

**Conclusions:** GOD made a new everlasting name for Himself. In Acts 2:38, Apostle Paul executed the command that JESUS gave in Matthew 18:18-19. Colossians 3:17

"And whatsoever ye do in word or deed do it all in name of Lord Jesus." Acts 4:12 There is no other name to be saved.

**Today there is much confusion  
in the Church about Baptizing In the  
Name of JESUS**

Can we resolve this serious problem in a brochure? Well, it all depends if the readers have a love for Truth in the name of JESUS!

Some Christians say we will only baptize the way Jesus commanded us in Matthew 28:18-19 - In the name of the Father, in the name of the Son, in the name of the Holy Ghost.

But some Christians follow the instruction that Apostle Peter gave us in Acts 2:38 to baptize in the name of JESUS for the remission of sins. They believe that they are executing the command that JESUS gave.

Listen carefully, this brochure can help resolve this serious problem if you have a love for truth. We are not going to cover all of the foundational scriptures in this brochure; however, we will cover enough to explain that JESUS was tasked to declare a new, glorious, and everlasting name for the Father! And the name of the Son, and the Holy Ghost!

**Note: We used the KJV to prepare this brochure. We have discovered the NIV has changed these scriptures.**

**God made his Son, his servant and gave him for a covenant and light!**

Isaiah 42:1-6 Behold my servant, whom I uphold; mine elect, in whom my soul delighteth; I have put my spirit upon him: he shall bring forth judgment to the Gentiles. ... and give thee for a covenant of the people..."

**The Covenant is explained in Isaiah 59:20-21.**

**God and His Spirit sent the Word.** Isaiah 48:16 (God and His Spirit has sent me) Here "me" is the Word of God. To receive this revelation you must understand what is recorded at 1 John 5:7: For there are three that bear record in heaven: the Father, The Word, and the Holy Ghost and these three are one.

**The NIV changed this text by removing this foundation.** The NIV changed this text to read: "For there are three that testify:" **There is no mention of: the Father, The Word, and the Holy Ghost.**

Next the NIV links 5:7 to 5:8; this stratagem was used to deceive the saints of God. Without cross-references, the reader would never know the deletion of this foundation has occurred. Here it is important to understand that "me" is the **Word of God.**

**It is of utmost importance to allow the Word of GOD to speak for itself.**

**We must remember that the Word was with God in the beginning, however, the Son was begotten.**

In John 3:16-17 Jesus says; (16) For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.

One of the tasks performed by Jesus Christ was to Manifest The Father's name unto the men which thou gavest Him out of the world (John 17:6). John 5:43 says, Jesus Christ came in His Father's name. Mary and Joseph did not name Jesus Christ. However, His Father the only true God named him through the angel Gabriel.

Isaiah 62:1-2 says, "For ZION'S sake will I not hold my peace, and for Jerusalem's sake I will not rest, until the righteousness thereof go forth as brightness, and the salvation thereof as a lamp that burneth. And the Gentiles shall see thy righteousness, and all kings thy glory: and thou shalt be called **by a new name**, which the mouth of the LORD shall name. Revelation 3:12 Jesus says, "Him that overcometh will I make a pillar in the temple of my God, and he shall go no more out: and I will write upon him the **name of my God**, and the name of the city of my God, which is new Jerusalem, which cometh down out of heaven from my God: and I will write upon him **my new name.**"
